Multi-Stakeholder-Partnership Training Programme for Civil Society

Organizations Offered by ENGAGEMENT GLOBAL - bengo on behalf of the Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and

Development (BMZ) and carried out by the expert for stakeholder dialogues and collaboration processes: the Collective Leadership Institute (CLI)

The training programme offered here is aimed at civil society actors who are planning or already implementing an MSP project and who meet the eligibility requirements of bengo. The aim is to gain a mutual understanding of the partnership building process and co-develop it further based on the acquired knowledge and skills. The training programme complements the technical and content-related consultation provided by the bengo team with the following training formats:

Formats for gaining general knowledge and overview of the methodologies:

- Basic & Advanced Trainings (3 days with 5 hours each day) providing a profound methodological and practical overview on planning and implementing MSPs.
- Focus sessions (2 hours) providing a general overview of an MSP topic.

Formats for ongoing MSP projects only (it is required to participate as a team)

- Thematic learning days (1 day) targeting practical MSP topics and competencies.
- Tailored trainings on MSP project planning (3 days) for individual MSP projects (upon request with bengo).

All formats are based on the **©Dialogic Change Model** – a 4-phase process methodology for building successful multi-stakeholder partnerships, which is developed by CLI and derived from long-standing experience in MSP.

MSP Basic Training

3 days online | Language: English

For whom: MSP practitioners who have little experience in multi-stakeholder partnerships (MSPs), but plan to prepare and implement a MSP project and apply for funding.

What will you learn?

- Requirements for an MSP project
- Getting to know the ©Dialogic Change Model (focus on Phase 1 + 2) as a process model for MSPs.
- Analysing your stakeholder system
- Developing successful engagement processes with key stakeholders and building a container for change
- Designing roadmaps towards successful collaborative stakeholder events

MSP Advanced Training

3 days online | English will be available again after May 2024

For whom: Civil society actors who have participated in the Basic Training, have experience in MSPs and have a foundational knowledge of partnership approaches and the Dialogic Change Model.

What will you learn?

- Advanced understanding of Phase 2 and 3 of the Dialogic Change Model
- Developing structures for successful MSPs
- Conducting process monitoring in MSPs
- Improving process designs for MSP implementation

! Important to know for MSP basic and advanced trainings: Participation requires filling in a detailed pre-questionnaire. We recommend participation in small teams of your MSP project and bring in your MSP project as a case for applying the methodologies. The interactive format requires your full presence and active participation.





MSP Thematic Learning Days

1 day – Online

Languages: English, French, Spanish

For whom: MSP project teams who are already implementing an MSP project (participation as a MSP project team is required) and have already foundational knowledge of partnership approaches as well as the Dialogic Change Model.

What & how? The thematic learning days target MSP specific skills and tools for planning and implementation. MSP project teams jointly improve their common understanding of a specific topic and directly apply the learned methods and tools on their MSP project. Therefore, it is required to participate as a team and bring in your MSP project as a case for applying the methodologies. The interactive format requires your full presence and active participation.

Upcoming Thematic Learning Days in 2024

- Facilitation skills (17.01.): Acquiring skills in facilitating dialogue between diverse set of stakeholders with different perspectives and interests.
- Process Monitoring (06.02.): Using the collaboration catalysts for keeping track of quality of process architectures and ensuring system's aliveness throughout the process. Establishing a learning culture.
